In more recent times it housed the first Stanardsville telephone exchange and the local newspaper.

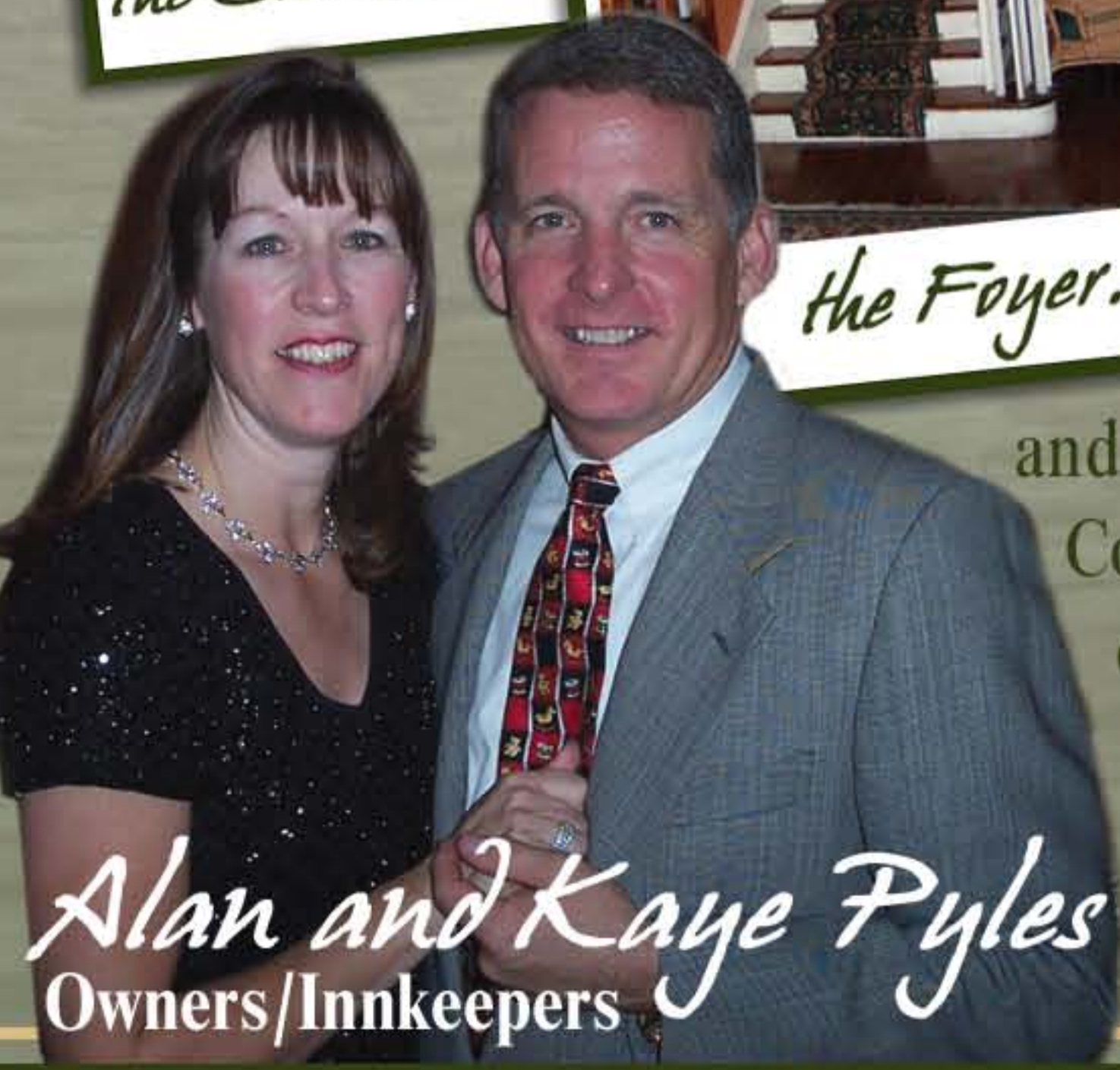
